



Marc C. Hochberg, MD MPH (USA)

Marc C. Hochberg is Professor of Medicine and of Epidemiology and Public Health, as well as Head of the Division of Rheumatology and Clinical Immunology, at the University of Maryland School of Medicine in Baltimore, MD, USA.

Dr Hochberg graduated from Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster, Pennsylvania *cum laude* and earned his medical degree from The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in 1973. He completed his post-graduate training in medicine at The Johns Hopkins Hospital and completed his fellowship in rheumatology at The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and Hospital. Dr Hochberg also holds a Master of Public Health degree from The Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health. He joined the faculty at the University of Maryland School of Medicine in 1991.

Dr Hochberg is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, American College of Rheumatology and the Royal Society of Medicine (UK), and a member of the American Clinical and Climatological Association, American Epidemiological Society, American Society for Bone and Mineral Research and the Osteoarthritis Research Society International (OARSI). He is Editor-in-Chief of *Seminars in Arthritis and Rheumatism*, Editor of *Rheumatology*, 5th edition (Mosby/Elsevier, 2011) and *Rheumatoid Arthritis* (Mosby/Elsevier, 2009) among other books and monographs, and the author of more than 300 peer-reviewed articles and 50 book chapters.

His major research interests include the clinical epidemiology of rheumatologic and musculoskeletal diseases, particularly osteoarthritis and osteoporosis, controlled clinical trials in patients with rheumatic diseases and pharmacoepidemiology. His research is funded by the National Institutes of Health.
